Others will have high stress levels and will need you to give them space to explore and gradually become familiar with a strange environment, in their own time. They may exhibit their anxiety in many ways and will need patient, loving care. These are the dogs that benefit most from the opportunity to live in a foster home prior to adoption. It gives them a better chance of a successful adoption.
